UNDERSTANDING TITLE IX: PURPOSE & PROTECTIONS

Title IX is a federal law that prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex in any education program or activity receiving federal financial assistance. This includes protection against sex-based discrimination, including sexual harassment, sexual assault, and stalking, in education. In short, Title IX provides our community with the following:

- Protection from sex-based discrimination, violence, & harassment.
- Ensure equal access & reasonable modifications for pregnancy and pregnancy-related conditions.
- Support & accommodations for victims of stalking, sexual assault, & other forms of sex-based harassment and violence.
